



Reopening for business **AFTER COVID-19**



SAFETY FIRST

Use the proper PPE and follow label's directions.

When handling infection control and/or prevention, Always wear disposable gloves when cleaning and disinfecting. Discard gloves after each use.



FREQUENT HANDWASHING

Promote and facilitate frequent and proper hand hygiene for employees, volunteers and patrons.

If soap and water is not available, use an alcohol-based sanitizer that contains at least 65% alcohol.

CLEAN, SANITIZE, OR DISINFECT?



CLEAN

Cleaning physically removes visible soils from surfaces by the means of a detergent and water.



SANITIZE

Sanitizing lowers the number of germs on surfaces or objects to a safe level. Sanitizing reduces the amount of germs by 99.9%



DISINFECT

Disinfecting kills germs on surfaces. Disinfectants need to be used after a cleaning agent and **must be left on the surface for 10 minutes** to be effective. Disinfecting destroys most of the germs = 99.999%.

PROPER HANDWASHING TECHNIQUES

1



Wet hands with water. Apply enough soap to cover all hand surfaces.

2



Lather. Rub hands, wrist and under fingernails vigorously for 20 seconds.

3



Rinse hands under water.

4



Dry thoroughly with a single use towel. Use the same towel to turn off faucet.

CLEANING CHECKLIST

- Wash hands.
- Gather supplies and PPE.
- Follow label direction, dilution rates, and contact time.
- Pre-clean surfaces with detergent and water. Rinse.
- Apply disinfectant and make sure the surface stays wet for the appropriate contact time.
- Rinse with water and allow surface to air dry.
- Remove gloves and discard.
- Wash hands.
